Online

DOT

- If you are renewing your Driver's License you can register to vote or update your registration at the Department of Transportation.



Mail

- We can mail you a voter registration application. Just call us at 724-284-5308.

What You Need

- Butler County residential address
 - You must use a physical address.
 - You may not use a Post Office, UPS store, or campground as your physical address.
 - A PO Box can be your mailing address.
- A form of identification
 - A PA State ID/Driver's License.
 - The last four digits of your SSN



What to Know

- There are two elections every year
 - Every year there is a Primary Election and a General Election.
- Pennsylvania has closed Primaries.
 - In PA, only registered Democrats and Republicans can vote in Primaries.
- Referendum voting
 - If there is a referendum on the ballot in a Primary, then registered third-party voters can vote.

How Can You Vote

- In person: Once you are a registered voter, you will be assigned a voting precinct. On Election Day, you can go to that precinct and cast your vote in person.
- Mail Ballot: You can receive your ballot in the mail and send it back to us. You MUST apply first.
 - You can apply online at www.vote.pa.gov, in our office, or by mail

Municipal vs Federal

- Municipal Elections
 - Municipal elections are held in odd years.
 - They are local elections where you vote to nominate offices such as: School Board, Township Supervisors, Mayors, County Row Offices, and more.
- Federal Elections
 - Federal Elections are held in even years.
 - You vote to nominate state and federal offices such as: Governor, President, Attorney General, State Representatives, and more.

Paper Ballots

Regardless of whether you are voting at the polls or on a mail ballot, you will be using a paper ballot.

- Make sure to fill in the ovals completely.
- If you are doing a write-in, you must fill in the oval and write a name on the line.
- Only fill out your ballot with a blue or black pen
- Do not use white out when you vote.

Did You Know..?

Mail ballots cannot be forwarded

PA does not have early voting

The USPS does not update your voter registration

Polls are open from 7am-8pm on Election Day

HOW TO CORRECTLY MARK YOUR BALLOT

Completely fill in the oval next to your selection.



Do not circle your selection or partially fill in the oval.



Additional Info

- Voters may only drop off their own mail ballots at the Election Bureau.
- Butler County does not have drop boxes.
- All write-in votes and provisional ballots are looked at by a computation board.
 - This process is open to the public.



Important Dates

- Voter Registration Deadline: Monday, October 20, 2025
- Mail Ballot Application Deadline: Tuesday, October 28, 2025
- Election Day: Tuesday, November 4, 2025
 - Polls are open from 7am-8pm
