On behalf of Mars Borough, I would like to convey our support for Butler County's funding request through the U.S. Department of Transportation – Better Utilizing Investment to Leverage Development (BUILD) Discretionary Grant Program for the Gateway 228 Project. The transportation improvements as part of Gateway 228 provide significant safety and travel time for our residents in Mars Borough and neighboring communities.

Mars Borough serves as the only small walkable town on the Route 228 corridor in southern Butler County. In Gateway 228 targeting transportation improvements to Balls Bend, a segment of Route 228 with significant safety and accessibility issues. This 1.6-mile, two-lane stretch is notorious for traffic congestion, increased travel times, and excessive crashes and fatalities. As the primary transportation route between Route 8 and I-79/Route 19, Route 228 needs to be updated to accommodate the growth in the Mars area. The safety of our residents is of highest importance, and we commend Butler County's commitment to improve safety and capacity along Route 228.
