ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this 4th day of January, 2023, in consideration of the *Policy Clarification, Medicaid – Long-Term Care, PMN-21139-468*, issued by the Division of Health Services on or about November 22, 2022, increasing the permitted maximum monthly guardianship fee for guardians serving Medicaid recipients/indigent incapacitated persons from One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per month to Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars per month, effective January 1, 2023, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED that, beginning January 1, 2023, all current Butler County Court-appointed professional guardians who receive monthly compensation in the amount of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars as outlined above are now authorized to receive Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars per month without the need to file a Petition for Fee Increase. The Butler County Clerk of Orphans' Court shall post notice of this *Administrative Order of Court* on the Butler County Court of Common Pleas website as soon as reasonably possible, and send copies of this *Administrative Order of Court* to all known professional/corporate Court-appointed guardians.
